Today, SOLIDAR, together with our partners in the Decent Work Alliance (ITUC, GPF, World Solidarity, ETUC), are celebrating the second World Day for Decent Work.

To mark the occasion, SOLIDAR is launching a booklet explaining the actions that the Alliance has undertaken so far. The Booklet entitled *Decent Work Decent Life: The Campaign So Far* will take you on a trip over the last few years highlighting the main goals and achievements of this global campaign. Other actions that the Decent Work Alliance are carrying out today include:

- A global handover of the signatures collected for the Call to Action for Decent Work to key regional organisations (the European Parliament in Brussels; the Organisation of American States in Buenos Aires; the IMF/World Bank in Istanbul; the Africa Union in Addis Abeba; the Asian Development Bank in Manila) re-emphasising the need to put decent work at the centre of the national, regional and international plans to confront the crisis.
- The Decent Work Game: Between 10-11 come and join MEPs and representatives from NGOs and play the Decent Work game in the European Parliament in Brussels. Test your knowledge of what makes work decent and see if you can make it to the ultimate goal of having a decent life! The game will be held on the ground floor of the ASP building, zone G.
