## FIRENZE 10+10: GETTING READY TO JOIN FORCES FOR ANOTHER EUROPE

Last Thursday (13 September), Maria Eleni Koppa MEP's report on "Enlargement: policies, criteria and the EU's strategic interests" was almost unanimously adopted in the European Parliament's Committee on Foreign Affairs. ## SOCIAL AFFAIRS

### MODERNISATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES: EP MOVES TOWARDS COMPROMISE AMENDMENTS

On Monday (17 September), the European Parliament's Internal Market (IMCO) committee carried out a [first review of amendments](#) presented on the European Commission's proposal for a directive on public procurement. Some of the points raised by networks in which SOLIDAR is actively working were taken up, including the Network for Sustainable Development in Public Procurement's [position](#) on the strategic use of procurement rules to mainstream sustainability considerations as well as [amendments](#) proposed by the Social Platform on the need to make quality a mandatory element when awarding social services. The vote on these compromise amendments in IMCO is foreseen for 29 November. [Read more...](#)

### EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT SUGGESTS CONCRETE SUPPORT FOR SOCIAL ENTERPRISES

On Tuesday, the committee on employment and social affairs (EMPL) in the European Parliament adopted Heinz Becker MEP's (EPP) own-initiative report on the EU social business initiative. From the definition to concrete support measures, the report includes many suggestions that SOLIDAR had suggested in the development of the report. Social enterprises are actors of the social economy and will as such receive important attention in the future funding period of the EU Structural

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

### TRADE AND HUMAN RIGHTS IN PAKISTAN: WHAT WILL COME FIRST?

On 13 September the European Parliament adopted its position for the adoption of an EU Regulation introducing emergency trade preferences for Pakistan. With the aim of supporting the country's recovery after the 2010 floods, the regulation will accord time-limited trade preference to Pakistan (i.e. a reduction of duties on key imports). ### WHO IS PAYING FOR CRISIS? EUROPEAN AUSTERITY MEASURES AND IMPACT ON DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

On 12 September, the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) published its [Trade and Development Report 2012](#), offering a review of recent trends in the global economy and the links between income distribution, growth and development. The report marks the structural reform policies being designed in Europe as destabilising and states that they are "all too often coded language for labour market liberalisation including wage cuts, a weakening of collective bargaining and greater wage differentiation". ## Migration

### POLICY COHERENCE FOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT: RIGHTS BASED APPROACH TO MIGRATION AND DEVELOPMENT

On Tuesday (18 September), the European Parliament's development committee (DEVE) adopted a report on Policy Coherence for Development (PCD), a commitment by the European Union to uphold development cooperation principles in its non-development policies. SOLIDAR, working with [CONCORD](#), successfully advocated for the adopted report to strongly reiterate the need of a human rights based approach to migration and development, as well as it including a thorough analysis of the development related push factors for migration, including unemployment and poverty.

## EDUCATION

### ERASMUS FOR ALL

On 19 September, the European Parliament's Culture and Education Committee held a presentation on the EP draft report by Doris Pack MEP on the "Erasmus for All" proposal for the 2014-2020 funding programme. Doris Pack kept in her report the three types of actions proposed by the European Commission: learning mobility, cooperation, and policy reform; however the activities, as well as a separate chapter on youth have been added. The report calls for a balance between the simplification of the upcoming programme and clarity on its content, while adding the minimum allocations per sector. [Read more...](#)
