Child Sex Abuse Kept Silent in India

India's focus on preventing sexual assault, after the gang rape and murder of a New Delhi student, should include stronger efforts to protect children from sexual abuse.

"When I got to the police station I was interrogated," said Krishna, who was raped when she was 12. "I was kept in the police station and was locked up. They kept insisting that I change my statement, otherwise they threatened that something would happen to me."

A new report says child sexual abuse is disturbingly common in India – in homes, schools, and facilities for at-risk children or orphans. Mistreatment by police, doctors, and court officials adds to the trauma. Communities often shun children who report abuse, and abusers are rarely brought to justice.

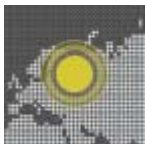


[War Crimes by M23, Congolese Army in Democratic Republic of Congo](#)
