It's 107 degrees in Iraq.

In a cluster of tents, Hussein and his wife desperately wait for water. Their five children, too parched to play, huddle in the scant shade.

They had to flee their home, which fell under the control of the Islamic State of Iraq and Sham (ISIS), a militant group responsible for widespread atrocities. The government has responded by dropping deadly barrel bombs anywhere it thinks ISIS might be lurking, putting civilian life in danger. To escape abuses from both sides, Hussein and his family left everything behind.
