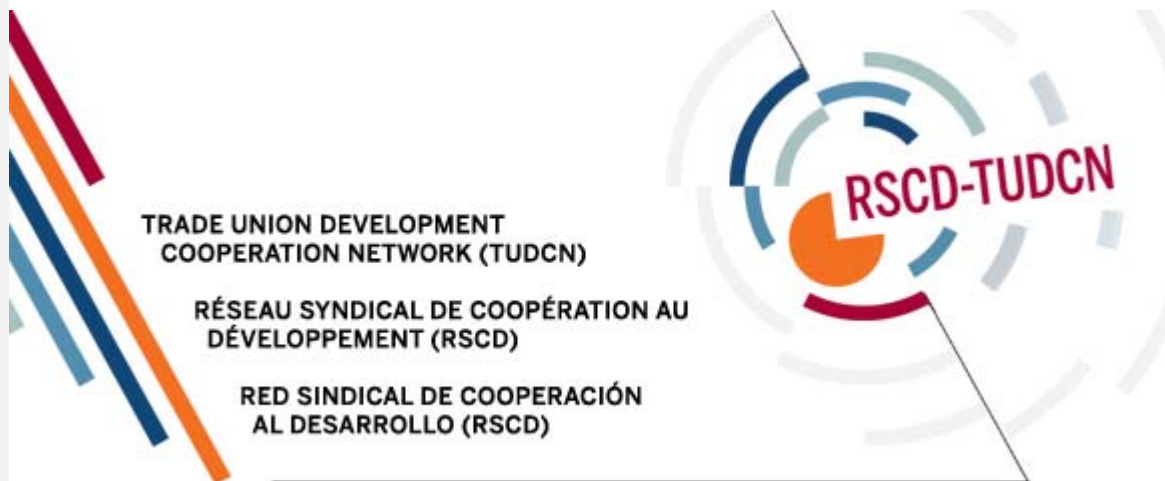

In March 2014, the United Nations published 19 focus areas, as the basis for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) negotiations. The list has now been updated.





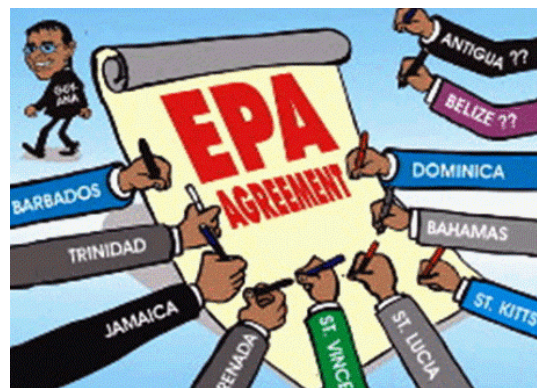
