In August, reporters from the WSWS were on site in Ferguson, Missouri in the aftermath of the police killing of Michael Brown and the military-police crackdown on the city.

This is only a small sample of the work carried out this year. As of the end of November, the WSWS has published nearly 5,000 articles on all major political, historical and cultural issues. Toward the end of the year, we reached a significant milestone *with the publication of the 50,000th article since postings began in 1998*. All of these articles are available, free of charge, in the WSWS archives.

Looking forward, we aim to significantly develop our technological initiatives, expanding the use of video, podcasts and social media, while extending our work in new countries and languages.
